## Tinting a single image

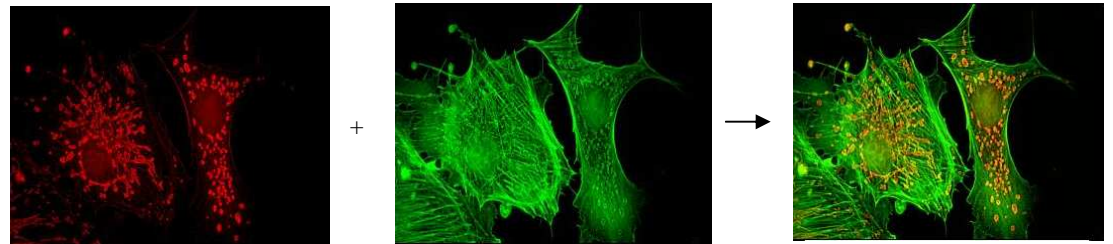
1. Right click on the image to reveal the dialog below



2. Select appropriate tint, Red, Green or Blue
3. If required you can select a specific dye by choosing **Apply Dye Tint**
4. The image is now tinted – this will reload as a colour images in Image-Pro Plus and Q Capture Pro 6.x upwards.
5. Outside Image-Pro or Q Capture-Pro the image will be monochrome. To save it as a colour image you must convert it to RGB format. To do this go to the **Edit** file menu select **Covert to** and **RGB 24**

## Making Composite Images

1. Right Click on your first image and tint
2. Right Click on your second image and tint
3. Automatically a third composite colour image is formed



4. This will automatically open the colour composite dialog seen below
5. If required you can adjust the contrast, brightness and gamma of composite image.

This composite image will save as a colour image.
